Our Goals

- Freshmen Retention: Every freshman and at least 50% of sophomores connected to upperclassman (ideally same major) through mentorship program
- Community Service: Have at least 2 meaningful nonprofit community service events per semester
- Academic Resources: Increase the number of resources in the test drive by 50% and have at least 5 resources per major
- Professional Readiness: Host at least 3 career workshops during recruitment season with at least 1 being geared toward underclassmen


